

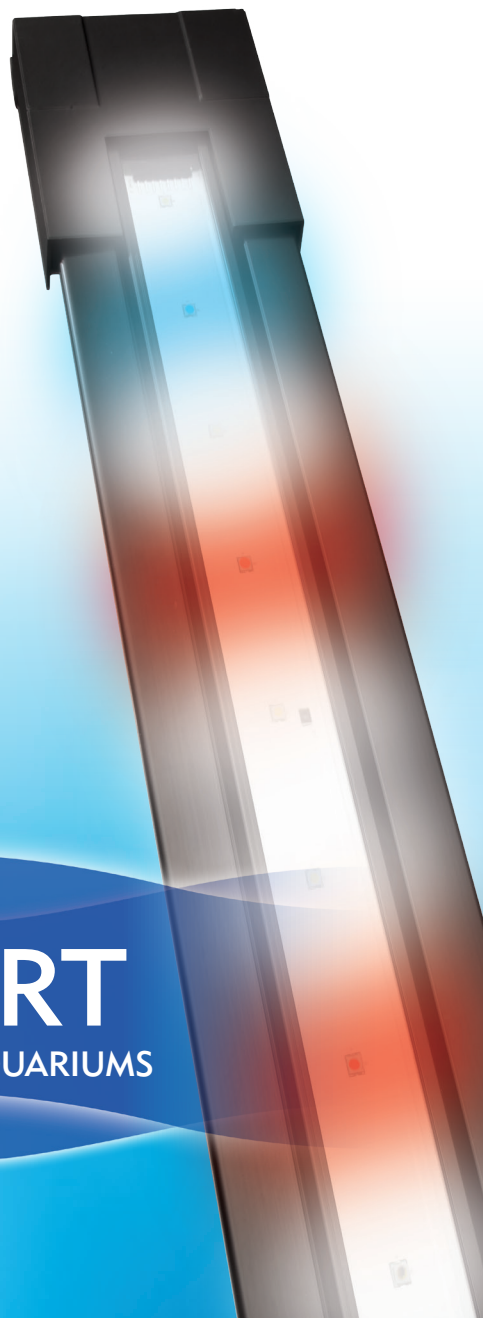

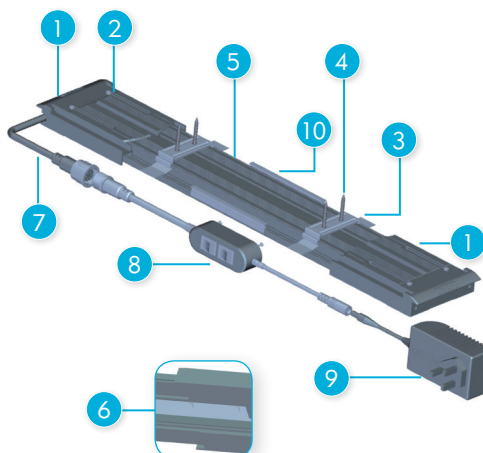

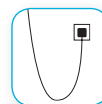
Getting to know your Tri-Spec lighting

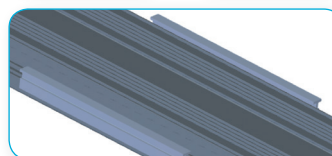
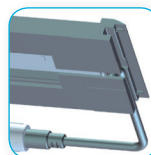
How to install your Tri-Spec HO LED lighting

1. The power supply transformer (9) is not waterproof – this must be mounted such that it cannot fall into the aquarium or be splashed by water. The cable must be installed with a drip loop to prevent any water running down the cable into the plug socket.
2. There is three options for fitting the Tri-Spec HO LED lighting unit;



Direct replacement fit with adjustable end brackets

- a. If not already fitted, push fit the adjustable end brackets (1) onto both ends of the Tri Spec lighting bar, see illustration on pack. Ensure cable exits out of cable tunnel as seen on line drawing below and then down to the back of the aquarium.
- b. Loosen the 4 location screws (2), place the lighting bar in position in the aquarium and slide end brackets (1) so that the bracket lips fit securely on the aquarium edges then tighten all 4 screws. If you have them insert the aquarium flap covers in the slot on the end of the bracket (see diagram 2 to the right).
- c. Then lift the aquarium flap covers to the open position and install the plastic spacers (12) evenly along the LED aluminium lip, this is to ensure the aquarium flap covers are completely level when the aquarium flaps are in the closed position.

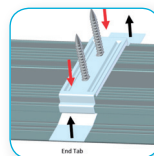


Top tip...if the Tri-Spec HO LED lighting unit is replacing a T8 unit not a Juwel style T5 unit, it may be necessary to create a new set of aquarium flap covers to fit correctly. Contact Interpet CustomerCare for further information.



Under Hood location with retro fit brackets

- Remove adjustable end brackets as these are not required.
- Ensure the hood material is thicker than the length of the retrofit screws (4) to prevent them protruding through the outer surface.
- Attach the retro fit brackets (3) lift both end tabs whilst push fitting the bracket firmly onto the aluminium heat sink (5). See diagram below.
- Place the Tri-Spec HO system in the desired location under the hood and draw around the retro fit brackets (3) with a pencil to indicate their position.
- Remove the brackets and place them in the pencil marked position in the hood. Using the self-tapping screws provided fix the bracket in position using the fixing holes in the bracket. When both brackets are fixed in position push fit the Tri-Spec lighting unit into the metal retro fit brackets.



Top tip... If using retro fit screws is not possible, all-round plastic / metal glue could be used to attach the bracket instead, for example: 502 super adhesive glue. Always follow the glue manufacturer's instructions fully.

Above aquarium with suspension kit (Sold separately)

- This allows the Tri-Spec HO system to be suspended above an open top aquarium. Simply follow the installation guide included with the suspension kit.

Maintenance

Switch the Tri-Spec HO LED system off and carefully remove from the aquarium. Carefully wipe off any dirt or salt mineral deposits built up on the outside of silicone glue finish (6) with a damp cloth. Do not use cleaning agents that could enter the aquarium and harm your livestock.

Tri-Spec App Controller (sold separately)

The App controller allows for full light and timer customisation, simply swap the white and blue light controller for the App controller and download the free Tri-Spec HO App. Available for iOS & Android operating systems. For more information, contact Interpet CustomerCare for more information.

- This unit is for indoor use only – do not use outside.
- Do not use this unit if the cable or transformer plug are damaged or appear to be malfunctioning.
